New Initiatives/Opportunities:

**ICACC 2013** included the first Engineering Ceramics Summit of the Americas, to facilitate scientific interactions among researchers, engineers, *etc.* related to engineering ceramics from countries of the American continent, and to foster information exchange on the current status and emerging trends in various ceramic technologies. A wide variety of experts from academia, industries, and research institutes discussed current status and emerging trends in various ceramic technologies of those countries.

ECD established the Engineering Ceramics Division Global Young Investigator (GYI) Award, to recognize the outstanding young ceramic engineer and scientist whose achievements have been significant to the profession and to the general welfare of community around the globe, starting from ICACC 2014. The award will be presented in the Plenary Session of ICACC, and the winner will deliver a keynote lecture at the Global Young Investigator Forum of the ICACC meeting. The award consists of US\$1,000 honorarium and a certificate containing a citation of achievement on which the award is based, as well as complimentary registration.
