Global Engagement in Ceramic Science and Technology (GECST) Program

The GECST program continued in its second year with the aim of encouraging, developing, and promoting students and young professionals in the field of ceramic science and technology through the active involvement and participation in the ECD. The program will also develop and foster cooperation among young professionals from different parts of the world. The program also sponsors the ACerS's Global Graduate Researchers Network (GGRN) Membership while encouraging an equal number of student sponsorships by Professors/Universities (allowing multi-year registration and leveraging of resources). During the period from Feb. 2017 to August 2017, about 60 new GGRN members have joined ECD, with nearly 178 member-years, through this program. We acknowledge Manabu Fukushima's and Surojit Gupta's highly dedicated work for this program.

ECD has 1,994 members as of August 31, 2017.
